



## Training officer report 2020.

I am currently on maternity leave which has meant a significant proportion of this year has been occupied with personal commitments.

Unfortunately, many training opportunities this year have been significantly affected by the coronavirus pandemic including our usual training which this year would have been offered as part of symposium mammographicum. Updates on this are available on our website and more specific details in the secretary's report.

Some training has been done this year via various online platforms and information about appropriate breast related opportunities have been added to our ABC website or disseminated via our newsletter.

Our excellent new website is running well and I would encourage everyone to review this when you can to see the changes. Various sections include learning opportunities, up to date information on the credential and events and your members only section with useful information, automatic membership renewal and networking opportunities.

To access the members only area, simply go to the log in page and after initially requesting a password, you will be assigned your own individual password which will enable you to access the members only area.

In the members area you can also set up your automatic membership renewal which is replacing the previous standing order system. It's an easy process that is outlined as a reminder below.

1. **Access the website**
2. **Once at the login page**, you simply need to add your email that is associated with your ABC account and your password, or if you haven't logged in yet, then you can request a new password here. A new password will be sent automatically to the email address and you can then use that to log in to your account.
3. **To set up automatic recurring payments** through the system, select the **About** tab on the **Account Management** page and scroll down until you see **Select Membership**, select the type of membership you have and then fill in your card details.

**Once you have added your payment details** you don't need to do anymore. Once a payment is made in the future your account will update automatically and you will no longer receive reminders.
